27 June 2021 - 30 September 2021

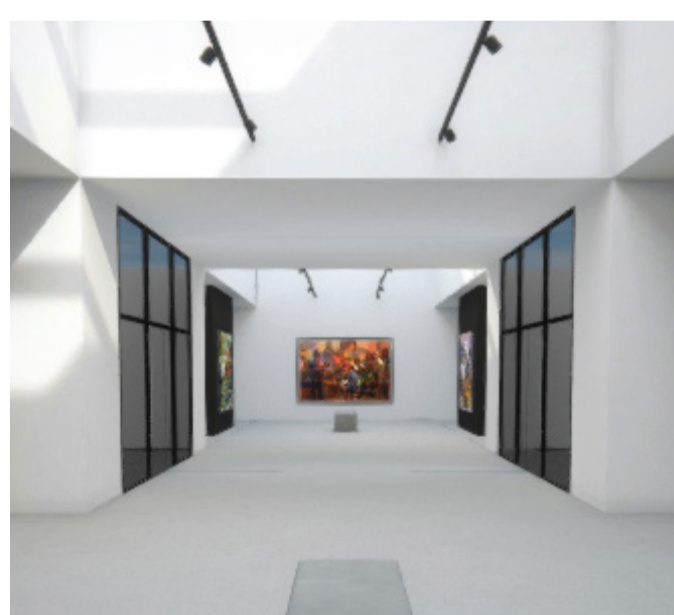
